

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2012-119, PASSED NOVEMBER 28, 2012, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-11, PASSED JANUARY 16, 2013, (THE POSITION ALLOCATION ORDINANCE), SO AS TO ELIMINATE TWO DISPATCH COORDINATORS, THROUGH ATTRITION, INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLERK/DISPATCHERS BY TWO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend ordinance 2012-119, passed November 28, 2012, as amended by Ordinance No. 2013-11, passed January 16, 2013, so as to eliminate two dispatch coordinators, through attrition, and to increase the number of Clerk/Dispatchers by two; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change would improve the efficiencies of the Police Department, and will save the City money with the salary; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to grant these requests as soon as possible to allow the filling of the position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby approve an amendment to the Position Allocation Ordinance, 2012-119 passed Nov. 28, 2012, as amended by Ordinance No. 2013-11, passed January 16, 2013, so as to eliminate two dispatch coordinators, through attrition, and to increase the number of Clerk/Dispatchers by two; as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That all existing ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
